

Important daily Vocabulary from the hindu newspapers are given here with their meanings in English and Hindi, Synonyms, Antonyms and Example Sentences .

### Irrepressible

- **Meaning (English):** Impossible to control or restrain; full of energy and enthusiasm.
- **(Hindi):** अजेय, जिसे रोका या दबाया न जा सके।
- **Example :** Her irrepressible energy kept the entire team motivated.
- **Synonyms:** Unstoppable, uncontrollable, unrestrained, ebullient.
- **Antonyms:** Subdued, restrained, suppressed, controllable.

### Pull Through

- **Meaning (English):** To recover or survive a difficult situation.
- **Meaning (Hindi):** कठिन परिस्थितियों से बाहर निकलना या उबरना।
- **Example :** With the support of her friends, she managed to pull through the tough times.
- **Synonyms:** Recover, survive, overcome, endure, persevere.
- **Antonyms:** Fail, succumb, falter, collapse.

**MENU****Race Away**

- **Meaning (English):** To move very quickly or increase the lead rapidly, often in a competitive situation.
  - **(Hindi):** तेज़ी से आगे बढ़ना, विशेष रूप से किसी प्रतिस्पर्धा में।
  - **Example :** The athlete raced away in the final lap to secure the gold medal.
  - **Synonyms:** Dash ahead, surge forward, sprint, speed up.
  - **Antonyms:** Slow down, lag behind, halt, pause.

## Nudge (V)

- **English Meaning:** To gently push or encourage someone or something.
  - **Hindi Meaning:** धीरे से धक्का देना या किसी को प्रेरित करना
  - **Synonyms:** Push, prod, prompt, urge, encourage
  - **Antonyms:** Shove, force, repel, discourage
- 

## Jigsaw (N)

- **English Meaning:** A puzzle consisting of pieces that are to be assembled.
  - **Hindi Meaning:** एक प्रकार की पहेली जिसमें टुकड़े जोड़ने होते हैं
  - **Synonyms:** Puzzle, enigma, riddle
  - **Antonyms:** Solution, answer, result

## Travails (N)

- **English Meaning:** Difficult or painful experiences, especially involving work or effort.
  - **Hindi Meaning:** कठिनाइयाँ, संघर्ष
  - **Synonyms:** Hardships, difficulties, struggles, tribulations
  - **Antonyms:** Ease, comfort, relief, pleasure

## Daily Idioms | The Hindu Editorial

Here are idioms from the hindu newspapers with their meanings in English and Hindi, along with example sentences:

### 1. Bite the bullet

**5. Spill the beans**

- **Meaning:** To reveal a secret or disclose something confidential.
- **Hindi Meaning:** कोई रहस्य उजागर करना या गुप्त जानकारी बताना।
- **Example Sentence:** He accidentally spilled the beans about the surprise party.

**6. Bite off more than one can chew**

- **Meaning:** To take on a task that is too difficult or overwhelming.
- **Hindi Meaning:** कोई ऐसा कार्य करना जो अधिक कठिन या बोझिल हो।
- **Example Sentence:** She bit off more than she could chew when she agreed to handle three projects at once.

**7. The ball is in your court**

- **Meaning:** It is now your responsibility to take action.
- **Hindi Meaning:** अब आपके हाथ में है कि आप क्या निर्णय लेते हैं।
- **Example Sentence:** I've done all I can do, now the ball is in your court.

**8. Nail-biter**

- **Meaning:** A situation that is very tense or exciting, often involving a close contest.
- **Hindi Meaning:** एक तनावपूर्ण या रोमांचक स्थिति, खासकर जब मुकाबला बहुत करीब हो।
- **Example Sentence:** The final minutes of the match were a nail-biter as both teams fought for the win.

**9. Photo finish**

- **Meaning:** A race or contest in which the result is so close that it is difficult to tell who won until the very end.
- **Hindi Meaning:** एक ऐसी स्थिति जब कोई प्रतियोगिता बहुत करीबी होती है और परिणाम अंत तक अस्पष्ट रहता है।
- **Example Sentence:** It was a photo finish in the race, with just

## 10. Dead heat

- **Meaning:** A situation where two or more competitors are tied, with no clear winner.

- **Example Sentence:** The election results were a dead heat, with both candidates receiving the same number of votes.

## 11. Cliffhanger

- **Meaning:** A story or situation that ends in a very suspenseful or dramatic way, leaving the outcome uncertain.
- **Hindi Meaning:** एक ऐसी स्थिति या कहानी जो बहुत तनावपूर्ण या नाटकीय ढंग से खत्म होती है, जिससे परिणाम अनिश्चित होता है।
- **Example Sentence:** The season finale of the show ended on a cliffhanger, leaving fans eagerly awaiting the next episode.

These idioms are often used in competitive contexts or storytelling to describe situations that involve suspense, uncertainty, or a close outcome.
