### **Insurgent (Adj.) THE HINDU EDITORIAL**

**English Meaning:** A person who rises in revolt against an established authority, often as part of a rebellion.

**Hindi Meaning:** विद्रोही, जो सरकार या सत्ता के खिलाफ विद्रोह करता है।

**Example:** The insurgents launched an attack on the government forces.

## Factions (N)

**English Meaning:** Small, organized groups within a larger group, often with differing views.

**Hindi Meaning:** गुट, छोटे गुट जो बड़े समूह में होते हैं और अक्सर विचारों में भिन्न होते हैं।

**Example:** The political party was divided into several factions.

**Synonyms:** Groups, cliques, sects, divisions, parties

**Antonyms:** Unity, harmony, coalition, solidarity, alliance

## Ventured (V)

**English Meaning:** To risk or dare to do something uncertain.

**Hindi Meaning:** साहसिक कदम उठाना, जोखिम उठाना

**Example:** He ventured into the forest despite the warnings.

**Synonyms:** Dared, risked, attempted, explored, journeyed

**Antonyms:** Avoided, shied away, hesitated, withdrew, retreated

## Tactical (Adj.) : [The Hindu Editorial](#)

**English Meaning:** Related to the specific strategies or actions designed to achieve a particular goal, especially in combat or competition.

**Hindi Meaning:** रणनीतिक, युद्ध या प्रतियोगिता के दौरान किसी उद्देश्य को प्राप्त करने के लिए की जाने वाली योजना या क्रियावली

## Dastardly (Adj.): The Hindu

**English Meaning:** Extremely wicked or cruel, showing a lack of courage.

**Example:** The dastardly act of betrayal shocked everyone.

## Improvised (V)

**English Meaning:** To make or do something using whatever is available, without preparation.

## Potency (N)

**English Meaning:** The power or effectiveness of something.

**Hindi Meaning:** शक्ति, प्रभावशीलता।

**Example:** The potency of the medicine was undeniable in curing the illness.

**Synonyms:** Power, strength, effectiveness, force, influence

**Antonyms:** Weakness, impotence, ineffectiveness, fragility, powerlessness

## Bastion (N) [The Hindu Editorial](#)

**English Meaning:** A stronghold or fortress, a place of defense.

**Example:** The castle served as a bastion against enemy attacks.

**Synonyms:** Stronghold, fortress, citadel, fortification, rampart

**Antonyms:** Weak point, vulnerability, breach, opening

## Pace (N)

**English Meaning:** The speed at which something moves or happens.

**Example:** The pace of the race was too fast for most runners.

**Synonyms:** Speed, rate, tempo, velocity, momentum

**Antonyms:** Slow down, deceleration, lag, slowness, delay

## Camouflaged (V)

**English Meaning:** Hidden or disguised, especially to blend in with surroundings.

**Hindi Meaning:** छुपा हुआ, छलावरण किया हुआ।

**Example:** The soldiers were camouflaged in the forest to avoid detection.

**English Meaning:** Certain to happen, unavoidable.

**Hindi Meaning:** अवश्यंभावी, जिसे टाला नहीं जा सकता।

**Example:** The outcome of the battle seemed inevitable after the enemy's surrender.

**Synonyms:** Unavoidable, certain, inescapable, destined, fated

**Antonyms:** Avoidable, uncertain, preventable, escapable, unlikely

**Abjure (V)**

**English Meaning:** To formally reject or give up something.

**Hindi Meaning:** त्यागना, कसम से छोड़ देना।

**Example:** The general abjured his previous allegiance to the enemy.

**Synonyms:** Renounce, reject, forswear, disavow, give up

**Antonyms:** Accept, embrace, adopt, endorse, support

**Retaliation (N)**

**English Meaning:** The act of revenge or returning harm for harm.

**Hindi Meaning:** प्रतिशोध, बदला लेना।

**Example:** The country responded with swift retaliation after the attack.

**Synonyms:** Revenge, retribution, reprisal, vengeance, counterattack

## Repression (N)

**English Meaning:** The act of suppressing or holding back emotions, thoughts, or actions, often through force or control.

**Hindi Meaning:** दमन, रोकथाम, जबरन नियंत्रण।

**Example:** The government's repression of free speech led to widespread protests.

**Synonyms:** Suppression, restraint, control, subjugation, oppression

**Antonyms:** Freedom, expression, liberation, encouragement, release

## Tempting (Adj.)

**English Meaning:** Appealing or inviting, often in a way that makes one want to have or do something.

**Hindi Meaning:** लुभावना, प्रलोभन देने वाला।

**Example:** The chocolate cake looked very tempting on the table.

**Synonyms:** Attractive, alluring, enticing, inviting, appealing

**Antonyms:** Unattractive, unappealing, undesirable, repelling, off-putting

## Wipe Out (Phrasal Verb)

**English Meaning:** To completely destroy or eliminate something.

**Hindi Meaning:** पूरी तरह से नष्ट कर देना, मिटा देना।

**Example:** The storm wiped out entire villages along the coast.

**Synonyms:** Eradicate, annihilate, eliminate, destroy, obliterate

**Antonyms:** Build, create, preserve, protect, restore
